

☐ As we transition to our new volunteer database, **VSys**, we're excited to share some important updates about how volunteer roles will be listed moving forward.

Previously, we had around **120 different role titles**, which made it difficult for managers to ensure volunteers were assigned the right certificates, trainings, and resources. With VSys, we've taken the opportunity to **simplify and consolidate** our roles – making it easier for everyone to stay organized and supported. Below are the **new role names** you'll see in the system, along with what they were previously called:

- Advanced Care Volunteers Previously: Advance Care Planning Facilitators
- Ambassadors Previously: Ambassadors, Greeters, Wayfinders, Information Desk Volunteers
- •Care Crew Previously: Game Facilitators, Musicians, Volunteer Photographers, Volunteer Reporters
- •Community Health Volunteers Previously: Community Health, Food Farmacy, Teaching Kitchen Volunteers
- Department Support Volunteers Previously: Adult Progressive Care, Book Cart, Cardio Pulmonary Rehab, Child Life, Clinical Education, Emergency Room, Eye Clinic, Family Birthing Center, Family Practice, Infusion, Inpatient, Behavioral Health, Mother Baby Care, Neuro Progressive Care, OB/GYN, Outpatient Rehab, PACE Academy, Patient Transport, PCU/ICU, Pres Now, PreSurgery, Radiology, Surgical Services, Medical Surgery, Precious Beginnings, Pharmacy, and all other department-specific support roles

Dear Volunteers,

As we enter respiratory season, all volunteers are required to submit:

- Proof of Influenza vaccination or a completed declination form
- Proof COVID vaccination or completed declination form
- → Patient-facing volunteers: If you provide proof of vaccination, you will receive a sticker to show you are cleared to serve in patient care areas without masking. If you submit a declination form, you will be required to wear a mask during respiratory season.

← Non-patient-facing volunteers: If you provide proof of vaccination, you will receive a sticker. If you submit a declination form, you will NOT BE required to wear a mask during respiratory season.

When you email your proof of vaccination to your volunteer manager, please be sure to include the following information:

- Full Name
- Date of Birth
- Last 4 digits of your Social Security Number
- Current Address (including ZIP code)
- Location where you received the vaccines
- Date of vaccination
- The Presbyterian facility where you currently volunteer


⚠ Deadline: All information and documentation must be submitted no later than October 31st. Volunteers who do not have the sticker by this date will not be permitted to serve in patient-facing roles.
