Turning a long-held dream into reality

The Presbyterian Nursing Career Pathways Program is one of the programs that Volunteer Services donated to over the last 3 years. This program empowers our employees to pursue their nursing degrees while continuing to serve in their current roles, making an even greater impact on our community.

Jasmine Brown, a research specialist in Appeals and Grievances, always wanted to be a nurse—but for years, work had to come first. "I had to choose between work or school, and it always had to be work," she says. That changed last August when she learned about **Presbyterian Nursing Career Pathways**, powered by Brookline College. The program makes it possible for employees to prepare for nursing careers while continuing to work full-time at Presbyterian.

Jasmine enrolled in the accelerated LPN program in October and is set to graduate November 14. "I'm so grateful to Presbyterian for this program," she says. "It allows me to support my family while advancing my career."

Her determination has deep roots. In May 2021, while pregnant with her son, Jasmine needed an emergency C-section and developed many complications following birth. She spent two weeks in the hospital while her newborn stayed in the NICU.

"Something triggered in my brain when I was in the hospital, seeing how much the nurses cared for me," she recalls. "I have no family here and felt very sick and vulnerable. The nurses were so supportive, telling me to focus on my recovery while my son was being well cared for. I knew I wanted to be that way for someone else."

When her supervisor told her about the program, Jasmine jumped at the opportunity and received strong support from her leadership team. After graduation, Jasmine plans to begin work with the Med-Surg Unit at Presbyterian Hospital. She then plans to pursue her RN degree—bringing her full circle to Labor & Delivery, where her calling began.
