VSys FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Will we still use Galaxy?

- No. Your hours, schedule, messages, and account details will all be stored on VSys now.

Why are we switching?

- VSys allows volunteers to do so much more than Galaxy did. Now your manager will not need to spend HOURS logging volunteer times, uploading documents, and checking available opportunities.

Will there be a training?
